Recently, the University of Ottawa purchased a site license for ACD's NMR data processing software. This software is available to all University of Ottawa students free of charge. Simply install it on your Windows PC and use it freely on campus. Please visit the NMR lab (D'Iorio Hall 416) to sign out the installation DVD.

This high level software will read all types of NMR data and has many appealing features for data processing including the ability to set up automated processing and the capability to analyze multiplets and prepare text files of chemical shifts and coupling constants for publication. It allows easy annotation of the spectra with assignments and chemical structures. The data are easily incorporated into other programs for the preparation of manuscripts and theses.

This workshop will include a presentation of the software and lots of time to ask questions. If you would like to have some of your difficult data treated during the workshop please bring it to Glenn Facey before October 16.
